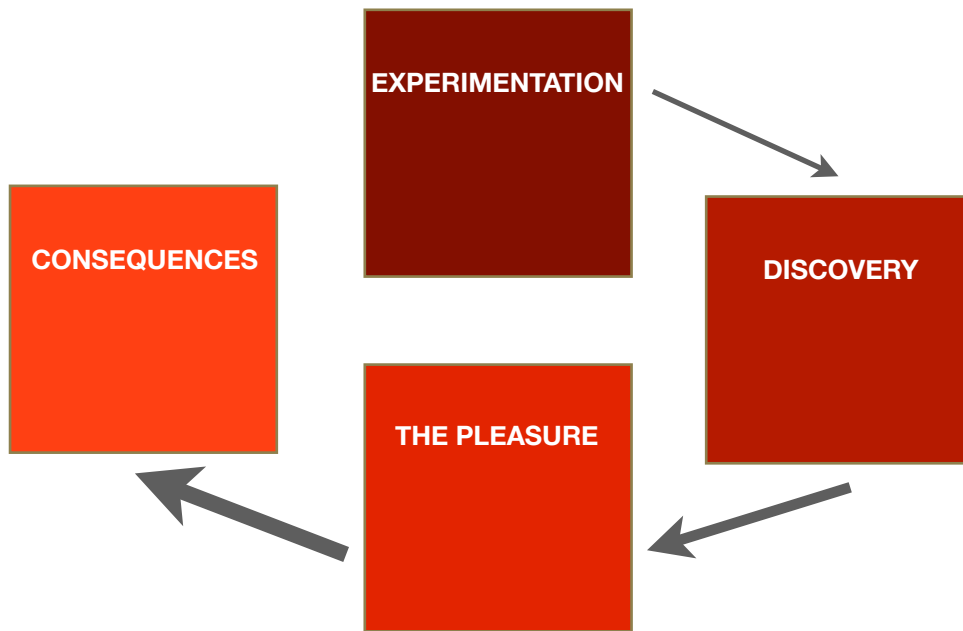

About the 2 days

Day 1

- An exploration of stimulant use and what is unique, and similar, about stimulants compared to other drugs
- An exploration of the Resonance Factor - the unique approach developed and used by Janus to work with stimulant users and other drug users. This approach empowers the professional to engage the part of the client that enjoys their drug use
- How stimulants affect the human organism
- Cravings and Triggers and how to communicate with them
- What is Addiction? - the 'ON' concept
- Physical versus psychological: the head and the body

Day 2

- How the Resonance Factor helps to develop awareness within the client regarding their drug use or their desire to become and remain abstinent

- Perverse Pleasure - the powerful relationship the client forms with all aspects of their drug use
- Using the Jo-hari Window with the Resonance Factor to develop an understanding of 'self'
- Transition and transformation – the pain of change
- Justifications - legitimising and prioritising drug use

Outcomes

The workshop aims to:

- Develop a greater understanding of the stimulant user
- Provide a variety of useful interventions to work with stimulant users that are transferable to all users of drugs
- Provide tools that generate awareness and ownership within the client
- Help the worker to engage the client and effectively support those who are motivated to change
- Provide a clear understanding of 'The Resonance Factor'
